In late November 2016, I [Min. Harrison] noticed random knots all over my body so I decided to meet with a physician who referred me to a specialist.

After meeting with three different specialists to complete a biopsy, the test results came back positive. I was diagnosed with lymphocytic leukemia on December 22, 2016. I was admitted to Yale Smilow Cancer Hospital where I began treatment in January 11, 2017.

I had chemotherapy for three weeks. While at the hospital, I learned that I had blood clots in my left leg. I woke up one morning and was unable to move my body.

During my hospital stay I had 2-3 different spinal taps to evaluate the cancer's progression.

In April 2017, I had two bone marrow biopsy where I learned that there were cancer cells in my body. In the month of May 2017, more

'How Often Should I Workout?'

Focus on quality verses quantity of days you exercise at a gym or in your home. Let's say you go to the gym for five days for an hour but only spend twenty minutes working out each day.

But another week you go to the gym for three days for one hour and you put in the work; go hard for an hour. As you see quality will out due the quantity any day.

Depending on the goals you have; the days will differ. Some may want to build muscle, training for a race, want to lose weight or just want to maintain an overall fitness and shape.

The training will be different in the amount of days you work out. I personally say four to five days a week is a good number. Even if you choose, for a couple of those days, to only go and walk Peace Be unto You. on the treadmill for thirty minutes; walk some and run some mix it up.

My training consists of weights, stretching, jumping rope, cardio, walking and running. No I am not crazy:

I know before I even say this. Choose a good mark to do a day: 10,000 steps a day. It is doable. You would be surprised how many steps you take a day without even noticing it. You can track it by a fitness tracker. There are tons of free apps out there on iPhone and androids.
