Then it was my turn, and I honestly don't remember what the guy said before he dunked me, all I knew was I came up out More years past on and in the month of the water choking on water because he never warned me to hold my breath.

Years passed on and I was brought up in Pentecostal churches. In every service my mother made us attend. I always felt out of place, like my spirit knew I didn't belong there.
