Greetings in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ giving God thanks and double honour to the Prophets of old, double honour to the Apostles and double honour to our Apostle, Pastor Gino Jennings. I am grateful to God. One day I was on my way to Chicago (an 8-hour drive) with my false church. The pastor and his wife had us listening to Pastor Gino Jennings - "AM I RIGHT." It really took me by surprise because they agreed with almost everything he was saying. I knew what I heard was the voice of God coming out of Pastor Jennings. When I got back home, I called my daughter and asked for her computer. Over a period of two (2) months I learned more about God than all my years going to church. I questioned God about certain things that those church members were doing that just didn't line up with scriptures. I told my husband I have to go and check this out for myself to see if it was real. I called First Church of our Lord Je-

sus Christ and left a message telling Pastor he had to come to Canada because of all the false prophets here. Within 20 minutes the phone rang and it was Pastor Jennings on the other line. Speaking with him I told him I was coming to the 25th international Holy Convocation. I then went to the old false church to question the pastor, elder, and minister. The pastor told me I was following a cult. Later that week, I took the Via-rail train to New York where I

slept in Penn station for 12 hours. I missed my train and got another to Wilmington, Delaware where Sister Dawn picked me up. During my first visit to Headquarters, I met Mother Dorothy Williams from Whitby, Ontario who has been traveling between Canada and the United States since 1995 - except for the 5 years she took care of her mother (Mother Richardson), who started from the basement of Pastor Jennings' mother's house. During my first visit to Headquarters, I walked in and saw people on their faces praying; I mean everyone from the young to old. I cried and I repented. I couldn't believe what I was seeing, everyone crying out to God. I couldn't wait to tell everyone here in Canada what I saw and heard and how

home I realized that I should have got baptized. It kept eating at my heart because the false churches added all of Acts

2:38; I just needed the name of Jesus Christ. Two month after returning, it was killing me. I couldn't sleep that I didn't get the right baptism. Again in October, I told my husband that I had to go back to United States to get right with God. I then got baptized on October 26, 2013 in Atlanta, Georgia. When I got home from that trip, I called Pastor Jennings. I continued to write letters telling Pastor how much we need him here. I prayed and cried out to God not to forget us here in Canada. One day I called Pastor Jennings and he told me to find a place to hold meetings. By that time, I was home every day calling and looking. We found a place but the dates were not good for Pastor Jennings. By March 2014, dates were set for our first meeting in which six (6) people went down in the name of Jesus Christ. Pastor Jennings told us to find a place so we can hold service every Sunday. I found a place for April 2014. Our first official meeting for First Church Toronto, Canada was April 27, 2014. Pastor Jennings sent Minister Jones for that service. One (1) was baptized. Since then, Brother Nicholas Brown from Atlanta, Georgia has been travelling to Toronto to preach God's Word. All praise is due unto God Almighty.

VISA DENIED

The Truth of God message is far-reaching and has gained the attention of many head-liners and high-profile celebrities. One, in particular, is the famous Israel Folau. He was one of the highest-paid rugby players of the Qantas Wallabies of Australia, who, not too long ago, came under scrutiny for comments that he made on social media against homosexuality and other immoralities. These statements did not settle well with the team nor his sponsors. Because he unapologetically refused to compromise his faith, he was released from his team and lost his endorsements.

Israel had been following the Truth of God and had proclaimed Pastor Jennings as being his pastor. I can't say that Folau is the reason Pastor Jennings was not permitted to enter the country of Australia, but we are pretty sure that because of his fame and declaration of the faith, it has caused the government to investigate the doctrine of the Truth of God.

Pastor Jennings was scheduled to be in Perth and Sydney, Australia, October 11 thru November 3, 2019. Because of his frank stance against homosexuality, the government of Australia denied his visa while granting everyone who would have travelled with him permission. Pastor Jennings did not want to cancel the trip, so he sent Minister Steven Williams of Philadelphia and Minister William Etheridge of Detroit, Michigan in his place.

Brother Ron Skotleski, the video producer, suggested to Pastor Jennings to set up a screen on the stage at Headquarters to speak via live stream to the worshippers in Australia and Pastor agreed. This was a first for the Truth of God program. Due to the time difference, this turned out to be very tiresome. In relation to the Eastern Time zone, Perth, Australia is 12 hours ahead and Sydney, Australia is 15 hours ahead.

Although the people knew Pastor Jennings' visa was denied and he would not be attending services, they still came out. It was beautiful to see all the saints come out of town to pitch in wherever they

could to make sure things ran smoothly. They assisted in the setup and breakdown of the rooms and with the baptismal candidates. Minister Williams helped also! I must say it was a bit strange to see Minister Williams lead devotion service and afterwards turn the service over to Pastor Jennings to live stream. Brother Mark Marinnie read for Pastor Jennings in Philadelphia, PA in the United States.

Needless to say, Minister Williams was ready, sitting on the edge of his seat while positioning his fingers in the Scriptures. He followed Pastor Jennings' lead as he was teaching and witnessing to the truth. Occasionally there were glitches in the video which caused it to freeze, but the people sat eagerly, patiently, and attentively until the kinks worked out. It was a beautiful thing to see the faces of people light up with excitement as to beckon him to preach and cheer him on with smiles, with tears of joy on their faces as if he was there physically. Also, I saw different ones give their testimonies of how the Word of God change their lives, sing songs of praises, and fellowship with one another. Even some pastors, who left the PAW organization to walk with the truth, came in with their congregation and now have become a part of the First Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ Inc. of Australia. In Perth, a small group from the LGBT community showed up for a silent protest but left without any incidents.

I must say this trip to Australia was an experience where a country is fighting against the Truth of God (my faith) for preaching what is right in the eyes of God. I have heard Pastor Jennings say that we would experience things like this with more to come but it's far different to witness it in person. Many times, our parents instructed and warned us of certain things which we now understand clearly since we have become older and matured. It was an eye-opening experience that I know we will see more of. But it was also an honor because I was able to travel for a worthy cause. I was able to meet people from the other side of the world who heard the message of truth, accepted it, and want to follow it just like me. I appreciated us being

there as well as felt the sadness when we left

Though the government of Australia did not allow Pastor Jennings into their country, the word of God was preached. A total of one hundred and ten (110) souls were baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. Twenty-seven (27) in Perth, eighty-one (81) in Sydney, and two (2) at the head-quarters temple in Philadelphia during the live stream services. Pastors were also baptized. Now, opportunities for future streamed services exist with requests pouring in already. If God is for us who can stop us? Nobody!

Currently, Australia does not have a temple. Therefore, some of the new members have taken it upon themselves to worship from house to house in Sydney, Cranbourne North, Melbourne, Australia. They listen to the telecast, sing, and testify to the greatness of Jesus Christ.

As of December 7, 2019, Isreal Folau reached a settlement. The Rugby Association in Australia apologized for any hurt or harm caused to Israel Folau. Mr. Folau stated he looked forward to the federal government allowing legislation to protect freedom of speech and religion for all Australians (CBN News).

Please continue to keep the saints in Australia in your prayer.


Healthy Eating

Greetings brothers and sisters,

I'm so grateful God has giving me the space and time to share something near and dear to my heart: health, consisting of fruits and vegetables, nuts, seeds, herbs, and never to forget wild edibles!

I first got into healthy eating and living when I was seven (7). My father and stepmother were strictly vegan and we healed ourselves when we got sick. It was a strong passion. It sunk deep in my heart when a neighbor down the street was sent home to die from cancer. The doctors said there was nothing else they could do. My dad and stepmom took it upon themselves to heal him naturally, through green juicing, and hot and cold water treatments. He completely recovered and the cancer was gone within a year. That was when I was around eight years old. Once I became a teenager, I moved

back with my biological mother, who didn't know better than to let me eat what I wanted. I ate everything I could get my hands on! Soon to realize I was run down and sick a lot. Now that I have matured and have my own children, I have come back to a healthy way of life! My biological mother and I are both very eager to learn. She and I have done many cleanses and detoxed together!



When I was given the opportunity to write this article, so many ideas ran through my head. What do I write? Juicing or garlic and grape-fruit for colds? Wild spruce needle and rosemary tea as a natural antidepressant, or healthy kids' meals and snacks my kids love? Then it hit me, my go-to, can't live without: smoothies! More specifically, green smoothies. I wanted something that could help anyone with anything, at any stage of their health journey. Everybody loves them. They are easy to make. You can't mess them up! You just add them to whatever diet routine you have at present. Why are smoothies with fruits and vegetables, the one topic I chose to write on?

In May 2016, a poll was conducted by NPR and Truven Health Analytics which surveyed a nationally representative sample of 3,000 U.S. adults. One question they asked was: how healthy would you consider your eating habits to be? About 75% of respondents ranked their diets as good, very good, or excellent. Yet 80% of Americans fail to eat the recommended amount of fruits and vegetables. So Americans really have no idea what a healthy diet is. According to a Harvard University study not eating enough fruits and vegetables can lead to many diseases such as heart disease, stroke, high blood pressure, cancer, diabetes, weight gain, and gastrointestinal health! So where is a good place to start: green smoothies?! I make myself and my kids a smoothie in the morning. I use the following ingredients:

3-4 frozen bananas

1-2 cups fresh or frozen fruit (my favorite is pineapple, it hides

any bitterness from the greens)

A handful of kale

A handful of spinach

One stalk of celery

Green powders (optional)

3 dates or a table spoon of honey (optional for sweetness)

Fill half way up or more with water and blend!

You can always mix it up and try new fruits and veggies or even simplify it! For breakfast my kids love to have their smoothie in a

bowl, topped with some quick oats, nuts, seeds and a drizzle of maple syrup! I drink it plain or sometimes with oats. I love it both ways! I also always have green smoothie popsicles in the freezer at all times! My kids eat them almost every day!

Just adding this into your diet once a day, will feed the good gut flora in your digestive track. The good gut flora eat fiber from raw fruits and vegetables and 70 to 80% of our immune system is found in our digestive track! That's one of the many reasons it's so important to eat fruits and vegetables every day.

The more you know about fresh living foods and our amazing bodies, the more you will gravitate towards eating healthier foods! Learn something new about health once a week and try a new fruit and vegetable in the produce isle! You'll be amazed at how your body reacts and don't forget to share the amazing new things you have

learned about health with someone else!

It was by far my very favorite part of this year. Just two months later I started PD dialysis and could no

longer be submerged in water. Our lives have continued to change for the better in many ways and we have continued to grow more in the Lord as we go and leave many old ways behind. We are not perfect and we still face things daily and will find ourselves in repentance on things here and there often through conviction, but we are very far from what and who we were. This is what I am most proud of from 2019 and I hope to only continue our path together and grow to be the people individually, and the family that God is proud of in this year to come and all that follow. God bless everyone this coming year with your own personal blessings and growth to look back on.
